From Seed to Tree - God's Gift for Growth Potential

In the Sequoia National Park in California, there stands what is believed to be the largest and oldest living "thing" on the North American Continent. It is a giant Sequoia tree – appropriately named: The General Sherman Tree.

Here are a few facts concerning this magnificent tree:

- Currently, the tree is 272' 4" (272 feet and 4 inches) tall
- The base circumference of the tree is 101 feet and 7 inches (101' 7")
- It would require 17 adult males with arms fully outstretched to encircle it.
- The mean base diameter is 32 feet and 3 inches (32' 3") with a maximum of 34 feet (34')
- This tree is estimated to contain 600,120 board feet of lumber a sufficient amount to build 35 five-room houses.
- In places the bark of this tree is up to 24 inches (24" or 2 feet) thick.
- The tree is estimated to weigh 1,320 tons (2,640,000 pounds).
- A single seed of a Sequoia tree weighs 1/3,000th of an ounce representing a growth rate from seed to maturity of 125,000 million-fold.
